Project Implementation Committee Co-Chair Judy Haner called the meeting to order at 1330. She provided a brief overview of the process of assessing priority watersheds, including identification of available resources and particular needs. Six watersheds were similarly assessed during the June 6 meeting at the 5 Rivers Delta Resource Center, leaving 15 more to be assessed.

Committee members worked through a list that included Dog River (including Upper and Lower Dog and Halls Mill Creek), Deer River, Grand Bay Swamp, Graham Bayou, Bayou La Batre River, Oyster Bay, Perdido Pass-Frontal Gulf of Mexico, Dauphin Island, Little Lagoon, Upper Blackwater, Rains Creek, Cedar Creek, Halls Creek, Negro Creek, and Skunk Bayou.

At 3:30, with only three watersheds left to assess, Ms. Haner suggested that we send the spreadsheet out to the Committee membership with a request to have each member populate the sheet with as-yet-unidentified resources and needs. Tom Herder agreed to do so. The meeting was adjourned at 1535.
