Old Business

Committee Updates: Updates were given on what other Management Committees are currently working on.

NEPORT Submission

- Jason Kudulis presented on GPRA projects completed between 10/1/23 and 9/30/24 that were submitted with to NEPORT.
- 8 projects submitted
 - o 3 Acquisition projects: 8,020 acres total
 - o 5 Restoration projects: 866 acres and 1.2 mile of stream channel

WMP Project Implementation Status Updates Request

- Watershed management plans suggest projects and MBNEP is requesting updates to the status of those projects.

New Business

Preliminary CCMP Survey Results

- Survey has been sent out to gauge where committees are coalescing around key priority areas for the next CCMP: sediment management, waste management, and community growth management.
- Preliminary results were reviewed. Deadline for submission is September 30th.
- Results will be used to facilitate discussions at the CCMP summit meeting October 24th, 2024.

Staff Report/Announcements

- MBNEP staff reported updates on projects in Lower Fish River (Schoolhouse Branch and Magnolia Bluffs projects), Fowl River (Fowl River Spits), D'Olive (Pine Run project), Western Shore (Deer River project, Shoreline management plan), Three Mile Creek (invasive species), watershed management plans (Western Perdido, Eight Mile Creek, Eastern Delta, Western Delta, Grand Bay). If anyone has interest in seeing projects being implemented in Fowl River or Deer River, contact Jason Kudulis.
 - o Save the date for a stream restoration technology workshop December 3rd, 2024.
- The Nature Conservancy
 - Perdido project, bids are opening up October 16th. Pre-bid meeting will be held the week of October 1st.
 - Mobile Airport Authority project is out for bid.
 - Bayou La Batre library project is out for bid. Storm water mapping in the city has been completed.
 - Lightning point project has been completed.
 - o Coffee Island project will soon be initiated.
- City of Mobile
 - o Segment of Greenway trail will be going out for bid and up for permit.
 - Langan dredging will soon be out for bid. Community meeting with be October 13th to talk to community members.
 - o LID near Zeigler Blvd.

o Nearing 100% design plans on Phase I of Brookley.
