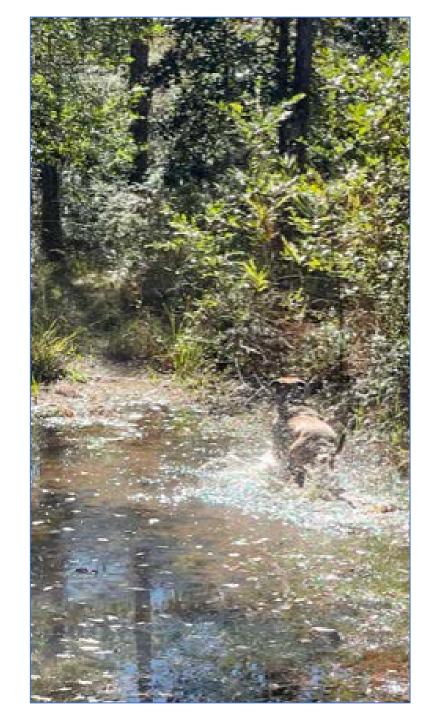

Bipartisan Infrastructure Funding

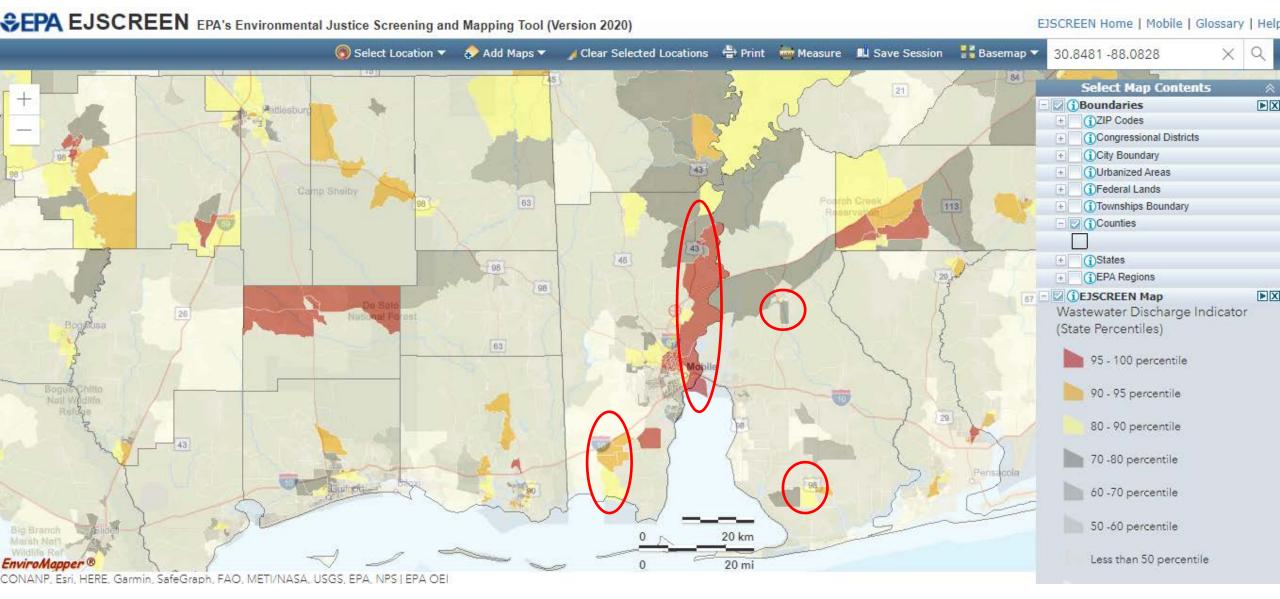
- Approximately \$915,000/year for the next 5 years (\$795,652 Available for projects)

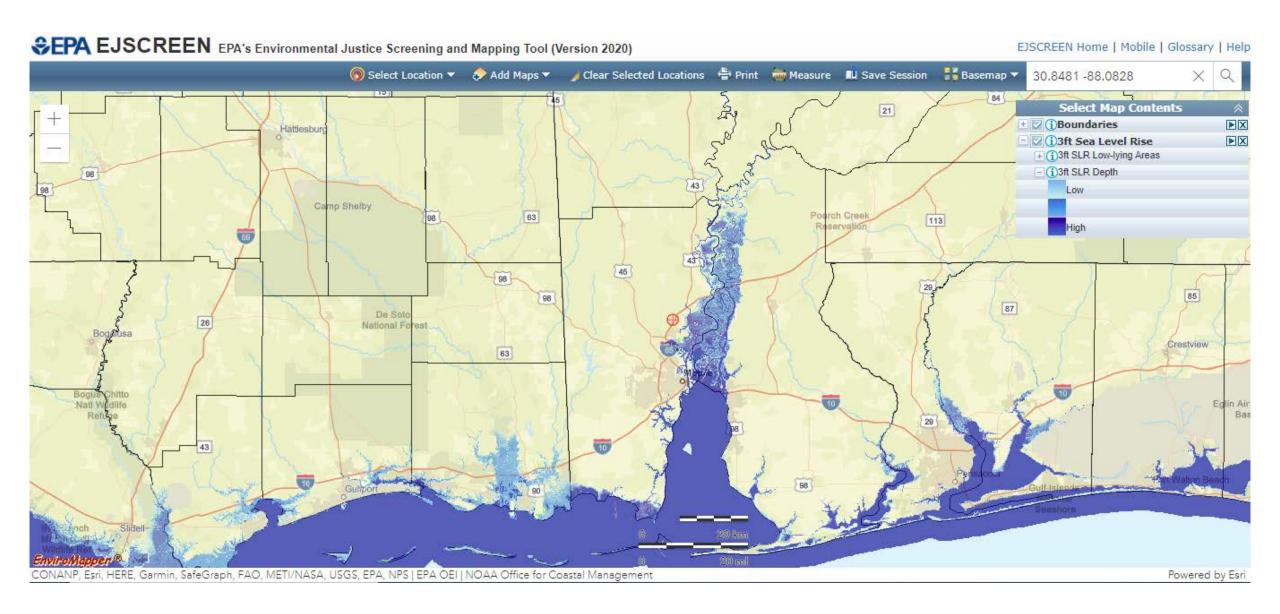
